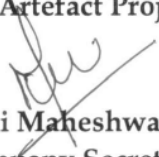

Demolish all illegal structures within 15 km of IB: Shah

UNION HOME Minister Amit Shah on Wednesday directed the authorities to strictly enforce a zero-tolerance policy against illegal structures within 15 kilometres of the International Border and demolish them, officials said.

Shah issued the directions while chairing a high-level security review meeting in Bikaner to comprehensively assess security-related issues concerning the border districts along the Indo-Pakistan Border (IPB).

It was attended by Rajasthan CM Bhajan Lal Sharma, senior state government officials, and District Magistrates and Superintendents of Police of five border districts – Bikaner, Jaisalmer, Barmer, Sri Ganganagar, and Phalodi. It was also decided to formulate a 360-degree security framework for every border district with the idea that an integrated approach “will actively involve local citizens, the state government machinery, and all

concerned security agencies to ensure comprehensive and robust border management.”

Shah also emphasised a co-ordinated border management strategy involving the Border Security Force (BSF), Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT), Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), and the state government to effectively address infiltration, narcotics smuggling, encroachment, terror financing, and other trans-border crimes.

He directed District Magistrates to assume enhanced responsibilities, including ensur-

ing full legal and financial compliance by all banks, verifying major business establishments, scrutinising their funding sources, tracking mule accounts and shell companies, identifying fake Aadhaar cards, and preventing smuggling.

The instructions came a day after Shah said in Bikaner that anti-drone systems will be deployed along the International Border in the next six months, in view of cross-border smuggling, underlining the need to view BSF's traditional role “from a new dimension.”

New coal mine cleared in ‘high conservation zone’ Hasdeo forest

RAJASTHAN STATE-OWNED electricity producer — Rajasthan Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Limited (RVUNL) — has been granted an in-principle approval to clear 1,742.6 hectares in Hasdeo Arand forest in Surguja, Chhattisgarh, classified as ‘high conservation zone’ category in government’s own decision support system tool.

The in-principle clearance for the diversion of large tract of dense to moderately dense forests, including felling of 4.48 lakh trees, comes with the specific condition that the tree felling as well as mining will happen in phases.

The Kente extension coal block (KECB) will be mined by the Adani Group, the developer and operator of the coal mine, and it will feed the Chhabra and Suratgarh coal plants in Rajasthan, as per official documents. RVUNL was allotted the coal block in October 2015 for captive use of coal at its Chhabra and

Suratgarh coal plants.

This is the third big coalfield that has been granted clearance; Parsa coal block (PCB) and Parsa East Kente Basan (PEKB) open cast mines are already operational in the Hasdeo forests, once earmarked as a no-go zone.

The Forest Advisory Committee (FAC), chaired by the Director General of Forests, granted the in-principle or Stage-I approval after appraising the RVUNL proposal in its May 8 meeting, minutes of the panel meeting show. The clearance also comes amid a sustained opposition by tribal groups, and representations sent to the FAC by civil society groups opposing the opening of another large coal block in the biodiversity-rich forest. RVUNL and the Chhattisgarh government have justified opening the new mine as it is “essential to meet the coal requirement of RVUNL’s thermal power plants (total installed capacity: 7830 MW), which have an annual coal demand of about 24.05 MT”, as per FAC’s meeting minutes.

All eyes on breakfast meet with colleagues; Siddaramaiah may step down as CM today

SIDDARAMAIAH’S TENURE as the longest serving Chief Minister of Karnataka is expected to come to an end Thursday, as he is expected to resign from the post. Though the Congress high command has not explicitly named his successor, Deputy CMD K Shivakumar is poised to succeed him.

Siddaramaiah has convened a breakfast meeting with his Cabinet colleagues on Thursday morning. According to sources, the CM has sought an appointment from Governor Thawar Chand Gehlot to submit his resignation. Shivakumar, who held meetings in Delhi on Wednesday, is expected to fly back to Bengaluru on Thursday morning to participate in Siddaramaiah’s breakfast meeting.

However, sources in the Chief Minister’s Office told *The Indian Express* that Siddaramaiah would submit his resign-

nation on Thursday, likely in the second half. Congress MLA Ashok Pattan, a Siddaramaiah loyalist, told reporters that the CM would resign at around 3 pm on Thursday.

Siddaramaiah remained tight-lipped about the end of

his term as CM, saying he would comment on the issue on Thursday. However, confusion prevailed among Congress ranks as AICC general secretary in-charge of Karnataka, Randeep Singh Surjewala, told reporters the party has not

taken a decision on a change of leadership.

Speaking to reporters after arriving in Bengaluru Wednesday evening, Surjewala said the meeting held in Delhi a day earlier had only deliberated on the candidates for the forthcoming Rajya Sabha and Legislative Council elections. “No other decision has yet been taken,” he said, urging the media “not to indulge in speculation”. The Congress, he said, was capable of deciding on the leadership issue. “Whenever we decide anything on the issue, I will happily inform you,” he said, adding a Congress Legislature Party meeting has not been convened yet.

Earlier on Wednesday, state Public Works Department Minister Satish Jarkiholi, a close aide of Siddaramaiah, said that though there was speculation over a leadership change, it would be confirmed only after the CM made an official announcement at the breakfast meeting. “Then there will be a full stop to this whole episode.

I don’t know what directions the high command has issued. We will only know at the (breakfast) meeting,” he said.

Meanwhile, state Industries Minister MB Patil dismissed reports of leadership change as mere speculation. “The question of the CM resigning does not arise. What has (AICC general secretary organisation K C) Venugopal said? His statement following the meeting is official. The official statement is final,” he said.

State Home Minister G Parameshwara maintained that he was not aware of the subjects discussed during the Delhi meeting and about the change in leadership. “We don’t know. But, there is a lot of speculation in the media,” he said. Throughout Wednesday, several Congress legislators met Siddaramaiah. State Law and Parliamentary Affairs Minister H K Patil, who met the CM, said he had expressed his concerns over change in leadership. “(Siddaramaiah) maintained silence,” Patil said.

HC upholds Asaram’s life term in minor’s rape case, cancels his bail

THE RAJASTHAN High Court Wednesday upheld self-styled godman Asaram Bapu’s life term in a minor’s rape case while acquitting him of gangrape, observing that Asaram’s frailty “cannot justify ignoring the victim’s voice. Quiet. Devastating. Irrefutable.”

In doing so, the Bench of Justices Yogendra Kumar Purohit and Arun Monga also cancelled Asaram’s bail, ordered forfeiture of his bail bonds, and directed him to surrender. The court issued a warrant for the arrest of Asaram — currently out on bail — and ordered that he be taken into custody and sent to jail to undergo the sentence.

Asaram had been convicted by a trial court in 2018 for the rape of a minor girl and sentenced to imprisonment for the remainder of his life. The HC Wednesday set aside his conviction for gangrape, aggravated penetrative sexual assault and criminal conspiracy.

However, it upheld his conviction under IPC sections relating to trafficking of a minor; wrongful confinement; criminal intimidation; sexual harassment; word, gesture or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman; and for being a relative, guardian, teacher, or person in a position of trust or authority who commits rape on such woman.

The court said it was in full agreement with the trial court’s “well-reasoned order denying leniency to the appellant”.
